**Uniform** Our uniform

consists of a royal blue singlet with white and gold stars with either the matching shorts or plain black shorts.

This uniform is worn at all levels of competition and must have the appropriate registration number sewn or pinned on the front and a 'Coles' patch at the top right corner. The age patch goes on the left leg of your shorts.



Shoes are required for all events. Spikes are permitted in the age groups of U11 and above.

### **Parent Involvement**

Parents play a vital role to ensure the running of events on a Friday evening.

We encourage you to put your hand up to help with your child's age group or in any other area where you may be needed. (Timing, starting, BBQ)

We have a committee of 10 members, some of whom act as Age Managers, so parental involvement is vital to the running of 18 simultaneous age groups' events around the oval.

We appreciate some families have 2 or more children so it can be a good idea to rotate helping with their groups.

We know every parent gets great enjoyment in watching their children develop their Athletic skills and assisting gives you the very best seat in the house.

If in doubt about what you can do to help, please ask your Age Manager or any member of the Committee.

## **Age Managers**

Many thanks to those parents who have already volunteered as Age Managers for the upcoming season.
